CHECKING OUT

Students	Three (3) books

ACCELERTED READER

ccelerated Reader (AR) program is designed to encourage young children to read more frequently and to establish lifelong reading patterns.

READING LEVEL

tudents take a reading test in the to determine their reading level.
Students will use their reading score to determine which books to check out based on a color code system.

COLOR CODE	
Color	Reading level
Orange	0.0-0.9
Blue	1.0-1.9
Red	2.0-2.9
Green	3.0-3.9
Brown	4.0-4.9
Yellow	5.0-5.9
Purple	6.0+
